Item-writing Workshop

Want to improve your item-writing skills to help you develop better exams for your students? NCCPA's professional exam development staff will share tips with you, and you'll have an opportunity to write your own items. This intense training session alone will be worth the trip.

The Ins and Outs of Exam Development & Scoring

Get a behind-the-scenes look at NCCPA's exam cycle, starting with the practice analysis all the way through standard setting. You will be able to use the information from this session to analyze your exams and to better understand exam data provided on the PANCE.

The Easiest Way to Avoid Trouble

Programs and students frequently contact NCCPA to ask about our disciplinary policies and how they impact PANCE eligibility and certification. In this session, you'll learn more about what needs to be reported to NCCPA, the types of cases reviewed, and actions most frequently taken. Information from this session will help you relieve students' anxiety as you guide them through the application process.

What Happens to Your Students after Graduation?

You teach them. You mentor them. You shepherd them to graduation, then they're gone! We will show you what our data tells us about what your graduates do next. We'll also share data from NCCPA's recent research initiatives that will help you envision future needs of the PA profession.
