

Timothy C. Evans, MD, Ph. D, FACP

Tim Evans was nominated by the American College of Physicians and elected to the Board of Directors of the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) in 2012. He serves on the Financial Integrity Committee, Research Advisors and is the chair of the Specialty Certification/CAQ Mega Issue Team. Since 2017, he has concurrently served on the nccPA Health Foundation Board of Directors.

Dr. Evans began his career in 1983 as a Research Assistant Professor and is now an Associate Professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of Washington School of Medicine. He still teaches there today in the MEDEX Northwest Physician Assistant Training Program.

Beyond the classroom, Dr. Evans publishes regularly in academic and research peer-reviewed journals.

He's been recognized with more than a dozen faculty and teaching awards including the MEDEX Northwest 40-Year Anniversary Master Faculty Award and the Physician Assistant Education Association Master Faculty Award.

Dr. Evans received his medical degree from the University of Michigan. He did his internal medicine residency at Duke University and an endocrinology fellowship at the University of Washington.
