Pat Kenney-Moore joined the Board of Directors of the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA) in 2019, as the Physician Assistant Education Association (PAEA) nominee. She currently serves on the Financial Integrity Committee, Review Committee and Specialty Certification/CAQ Mega Issue Team.

Kenney-Moore has 25 years of PA experience in teaching, service and administration. She was one of the founding faculty members of the Oregon Health & Science University School of Medicine PA Program beginning with the program's inception in 1995 and continues to serve as the Associate Director.

She provides primary care services at a free clinic, has published in national journals and is currently a peer reviewer for *Academic Medicine*.
